February 9, 2015

Meeting posted at the Pleasanton Post Office, River Stop, and Town & Country Bank.

The agenda was available at the office of the Superintendent.

The Board of Education for Pleasanton Public Schools, District 10-0105 met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. at the school. Members present were Klein, Pawloski, Zwiener, Hand, Nichols, and Kingston. Teacher representatives were Allison Albers, Casey Loomis and Kaylie Eckhout. Harold Brummer and Lynn Martin were visitors.
