## Bus Routes

## Physicals for Students

All students in Grades 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> that plan on going out for athletics, dance, or cheerleading must have a sports physical done before they can participate in practice or activities. Be sure to get your appointments done early!

Kindergarten and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students must have a physical and immunizations before coming to school. According to Nebraska State Law schools are not to allow students to attend without their physical and immunizations.

Preschoolers must have all their immunizations that are required for Kindergarten.

## Preschool

Pleasanton Public Schools preschool is currently enrolling 3 and 4 year olds for the 2015-16 school year. Preschoolers must meet the following requirements to attend: 3 year olds must turn 4 by March 1<sup>st</sup>.

Preschool will run from 8:10am-11:10am Monday-Friday. There will be daycare available for students after preschool is dismissed. If your child will need daycare service, please call the school and let us know as soon as possible.

## Pleasanton Childcare

Pleasanton Public Schools has after school childcare available until 5:30pm. We ask that you please let the office know if your child will be attending the childcare.

To ensure there are enough staff to cover the needs of the childcare during school, if possible please call the school office by 9am if there are changes to your student's childcare plans.

## School Lunch Prices for 2015-16

**Seconds: \$1.00**

**Student Breakfasts: \$1.50**

**Adult Breakfasts: \$2.00**

Step 4: Select the "Add Subscribed Calendar" option, fill in the Google Calendar URL in the Server box and click "Next." Change any settings you see fit before saving the calendar. You do not need a username or password.

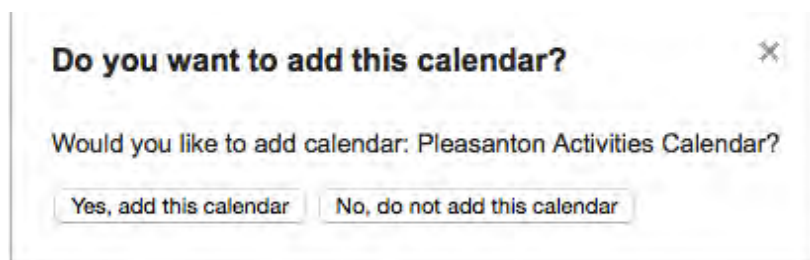

The Board of Education for Pleasanton Public Schools, District 10-0105 met in regular session at 5:06 p.m. at the school. Members present were Zwiener, Pawloski, Hand, Nichols, Kingston and Klein. Chad Dixon was a visitor.

President Zwiener called the meeting to order and opened with a statement that the board follows the Open Meetings Act, a copy of the law is located in the room.

Motion by Klein, seconded by Pawloski to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion carried 6 – 0.

Moved by Klein, seconded by Kingston to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting. Motion carried 6-0.

Moved by Hand, seconded by Pawloski to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried 6 – 0.

Moved by Hand, seconded by Pawloski to approve the last month's bills. Motion carried 5-0. (Nichols-Abs).

Mr. Westland reported on:
