March 14, 2016

The Board of Education for Pleasanton Public Schools, District 10-0105 met in regular session at 7:02 p.m. at the school. Members present were Zwiener, Pawloski, Hand, Nichols, and Kingston. Klein was excused (ill). John Brummer and Deb Blevins were teacher representatives.

Move by Zwiener, seconded by Pawloski to go into executive session for the protection of public interest to discuss possible land acquisition at 8:05. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Pawloski, seconded by Hand to come out of executive session for the protection of public interest to discuss possible land acquisition at 8:43. Motion carried 5-0.
